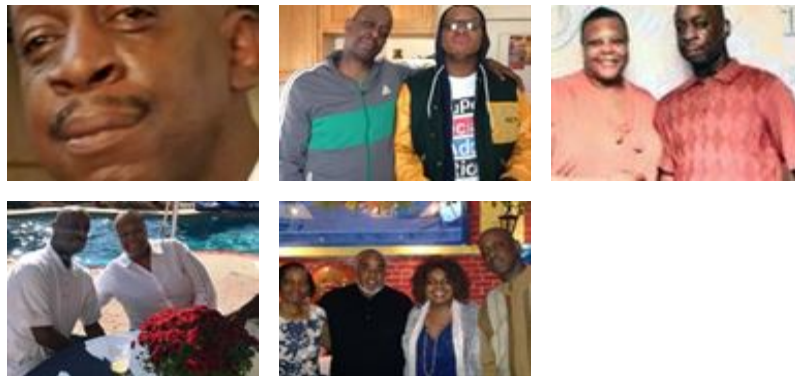
“ How do you measure the worth of a man?
