On Friday evening, April 1, 2016, the light dimmed on earth and Heaven's light shined bright as our Heavenly Father welcomed into his loving arms our Queen, Carrie Bell Freeman Cherry. Carrie was born in Bertie county on July 11, 1922 to her loving parents, Anderson Wright and Mary Cleo Freeman. At an early age, Carrie accepted Jesus Christ and joined Piney Wood chapel Missionary Baptist Church and remained a faithful member until her death. She was a deaconess and missionary. She was an active participant in her church and loved her Sunday School class. Carrie did not have to go to church to find or seek Jesus. She carried Him in her heart at all times. She showed us all what it meant to let your light, your love for the Lord shine bright in your life and your walk. She taught us how to love, how to pray for one another and how to seek God first in all things. Her one question? "Did you pray about it?"

On June 18, 1939, Carrie joined together in Holy Matrimony with the late James (Cledie) Cherry. This union produced 9 children.
