Obituary

The late Rosa Beatrice Watson Beasley was born in Bertie County, North Carolina to Audrey Watson and Walter Cherry on March 24, 1926. Rosa departed this life on earth to live with her heavenly father at 8:15 am on March 20, 2014, at her home.
