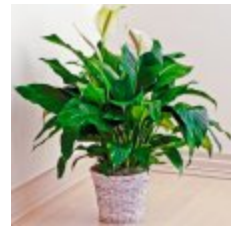

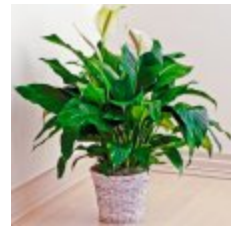
To my Pops...A gentle giant..sharp dresser..clean cut....shiny shoes...smell good...POPS...
